But... when posting code to SO, can you actually write code for an average programmer to read? Often it's more of a heads up, and it's only needed to show off some little technique, or how to do something more efficiently. I know this is a space for code, but we're not talking about source code. We're talking about stuff that a typical programmer can understand, and attempt to understand without having to go trough a graduate-level course on the subject. Should we request people only post this stuff as blocks of text like this? Or does the SO format mean it's ok to post code without having to go to the trouble? A: If it's code, it's fine. No formatting, since that can be anything from important to unimportant. You can format it by whatever you like after posting. If you don't want it to be looked at, you should not post it. I've already voted to un-put it. A: Ultimately, it doesn't really matter. Some people will cringe, others will have a great time reading it. It's up to you, but many programmers may actually enjoy the learning experience from the posted code. The block formatting allows comments and inline markup, as well as trying to keep the code readable. It's a useful mark up. A: We have chosen the format that lets us leave comments. That way, some people enjoy reading the code, some enjoy reading the comments, and some enjoy reading the code AND the comments. The
